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1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. Purpose

The purpose of this document is to describe the single sign-on registration process for a new user to access the National Department of Health (NDoH) Information Center.

1.2. Introduction

The NDoH Information Center contains the following portals:

- COVID-19 portal and
- Health Systems portal

The COVID-19 portal contains dashboards that support decision-making related to the COVID-19 pandemic in South Africa, mostly related to COVID-19 vaccinations. The Health Systems portal contains dashboards and tools that support decision-making in the health system for South Africa.




Figure 1 Health Information Center landing page with portals

The COVID-19 portal contains dashboards inside the following themes:

- South African COVID-19 Vaccinations
- South African COVID-19 Vaccination Management

The Health System portal contains dashboards inside the following themes:

- Health System Profiles
- Health System Spatial Planning

These dashboards use different applications to visualise different data sets. Typically, ArcGIS is used to display location data and Power BI displays statistical data in table or graphical format. Normally every application will require its own login details, authentication and storing of users.

The single sign-on process (SSO) using software called Keycloak, only requires the user to login to the NDoH Information Center. The user will then automatically be logged in to the applications on various platforms.

Only authorised users can obtain access to the NDoH Information Center dashboards. An authorised user will have access to all data (national), or provincial (specified province) data based on their profiles.

Separate applications are also typically accessed via different web URLs. Here SSO facilitates access to all included applications from a single, constant web URL where a user logs into the Health Information Center (HIC).

1.3. Scope

The scope of this document is to describe the single sign-on request and registration process of users of the NDoH Information Center website.

This document is available from and complementary to the 'Help' section of the NDoH Health Information Center (HIC) online.

2. The user registration process

Access to the NDoH Information Center happens through a single sign-on login process. A new user needs to submit a request to be registered on the system. Only once the user registration is approved will the user be able to access the NDoH Information Center.

2.1. The user

Access to the NDoH Information Center happens through a single sign-on login process. A new user needs to submit a request to be registered on the system. Only once the user registration is approved will the user be able to access the NDoH Information Center. Access applicants as well as designated approvers will receive email notification of each step in the process.

2.2. The user registration request

- 1. Open a web browser
- 2. Type the following URL in the web browser:

login.health.gov.za

The National Department of Health Information Center login page will open *Figure 2*.


Figure 3 Registration Form
